JIW is a Jacksonville Jaguars Honors Site, so Sanitra was able to apply to be in the Jaguar Foundation/UNF Community Scholars Program and has been active in it her senior year.

She has been involved with the yearbook for the past two school years.

The Westside senior has a GPA of 3.5 and plans to attend a college with an exceptional psychology department.

Koziol loves to read, watch movies and go to the park. She lives with her husband and teenage daughter at the Beaches.


Motivational speaker
