

Celebrating our 20th year, the Awards Celebration is the signature year-end event of the Journey Into Womanhood (JIW) program. Held in the spring, the Awards Celebration honors the program's graduating high school seniors and provides them with a modest scholarship. A keynote speaker is invited to share words of wisdom with our young ladies and guests.

Research shows that black girls and teens are more likely to experience low self-esteem and inadequacy than their white counterparts. When self-esteem increases, girls and teens see positive behavior adjustments, academic success, better decision making, and lower rates of violence, trauma and addiction.

For 20 years, Jacksonville's own Journey Into Womanhood program, or JIW, has been providing young women a 25-week program to help them ensure their place in society and hope for a bright future. It is a signature program of Empowerment Resources, Inc.

Since 2003, the JIW program has impacted the lives of more than 300 young ladies. Female volunteer mentors help participants cultivate their self-awareness and develop leadership skills to positively impact their community. The ladies engage in journal writing, community service projects and enrichment trips. The program shows outstanding results: participants show a 70% increase in self-esteem scores, a 96% decrease in substance use, and 93% of JIW alumnae entering college directly after graduating high school.

Who are JIW participants? Girls from across Duval, St. Johns, Clay and Baker counties, ages 9 – 17, 55% qualify for free or reduced lunch at school. The majority of participants are African American, from a mix of two-parent, single-parent and guardianship led families.

The success of the Journey Into Womanhood program is due in large part to the investment of community members, sharing their financial resources and time as volunteer mentors and presenters.
